## THE OPPORTUNITY

FSSD is currently seeking a candidate to fill a full-time position in the Operation & Maintenance Technician 1-4 series within its Maintenance Department.

The Plant Maintenance Mechanic performs or assists in the development and construction of new equipment systems and maintenance, repair, or replacement of mechanical and electrical equipment employed in the operation of wastewater treatment, pumping, and storage facilities.

### **O&M Technician 1** **\$26.87 – \$33.57 per hour**

The O&M Technician 1 is an entry-level position in the Technician series. This technical position receives on-the-job training and experience while performing routine duties assigned by a supervisor or lead technician.

### **O&M Technician 2** **\$33.83 – \$42.29 per hour**

The O&M Technician 2 is the second level in the O&M Technician series. This position continues to receive on-the-job training and experience while performing routine operational duties on an assigned shift.

### **O&M Technician 3** **\$40.28 – \$50.35 per hour**
